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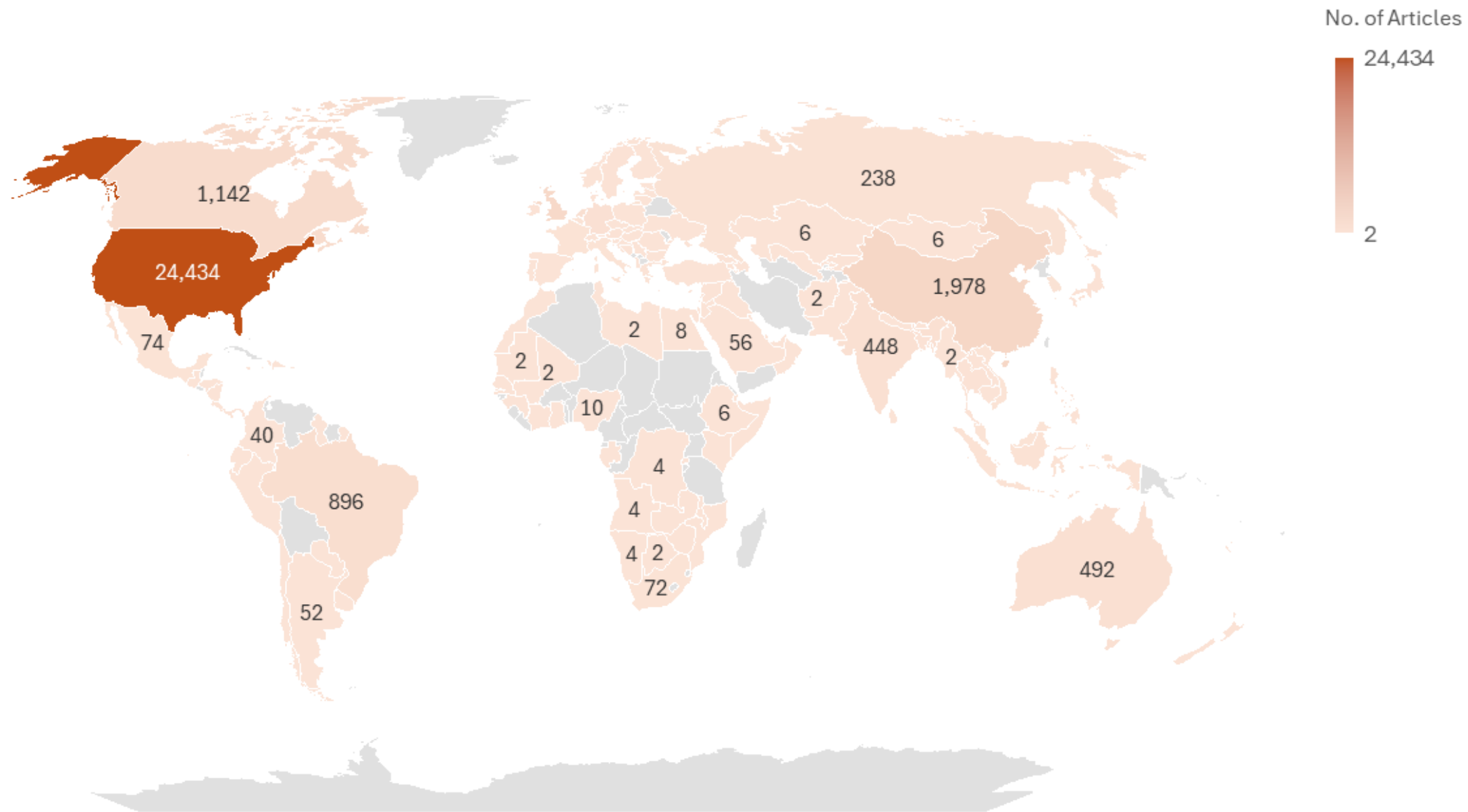

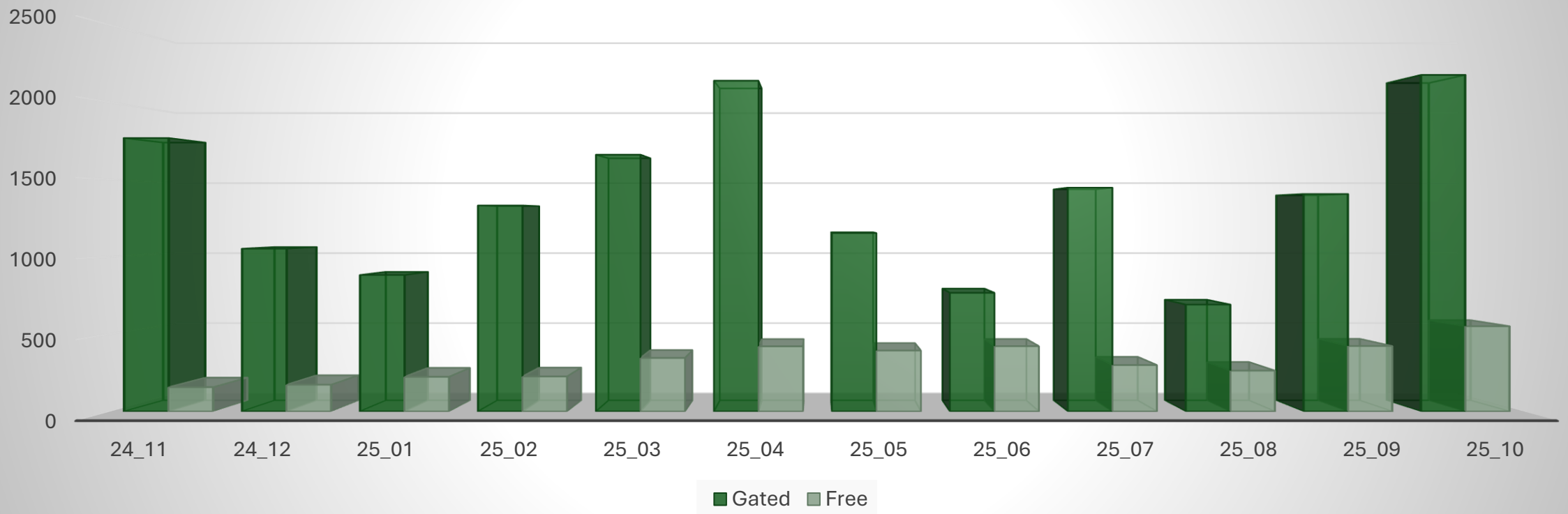

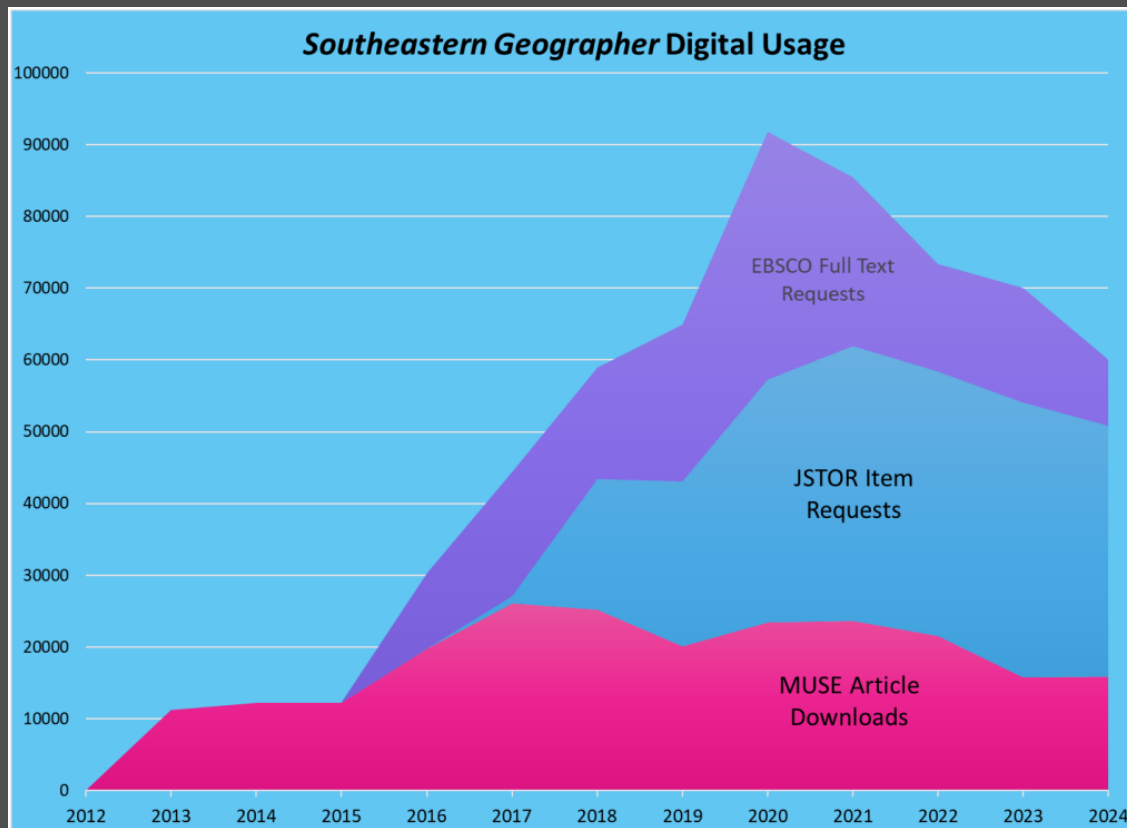

Countries that accessed SEG articles from Nov 24 to Oct-25



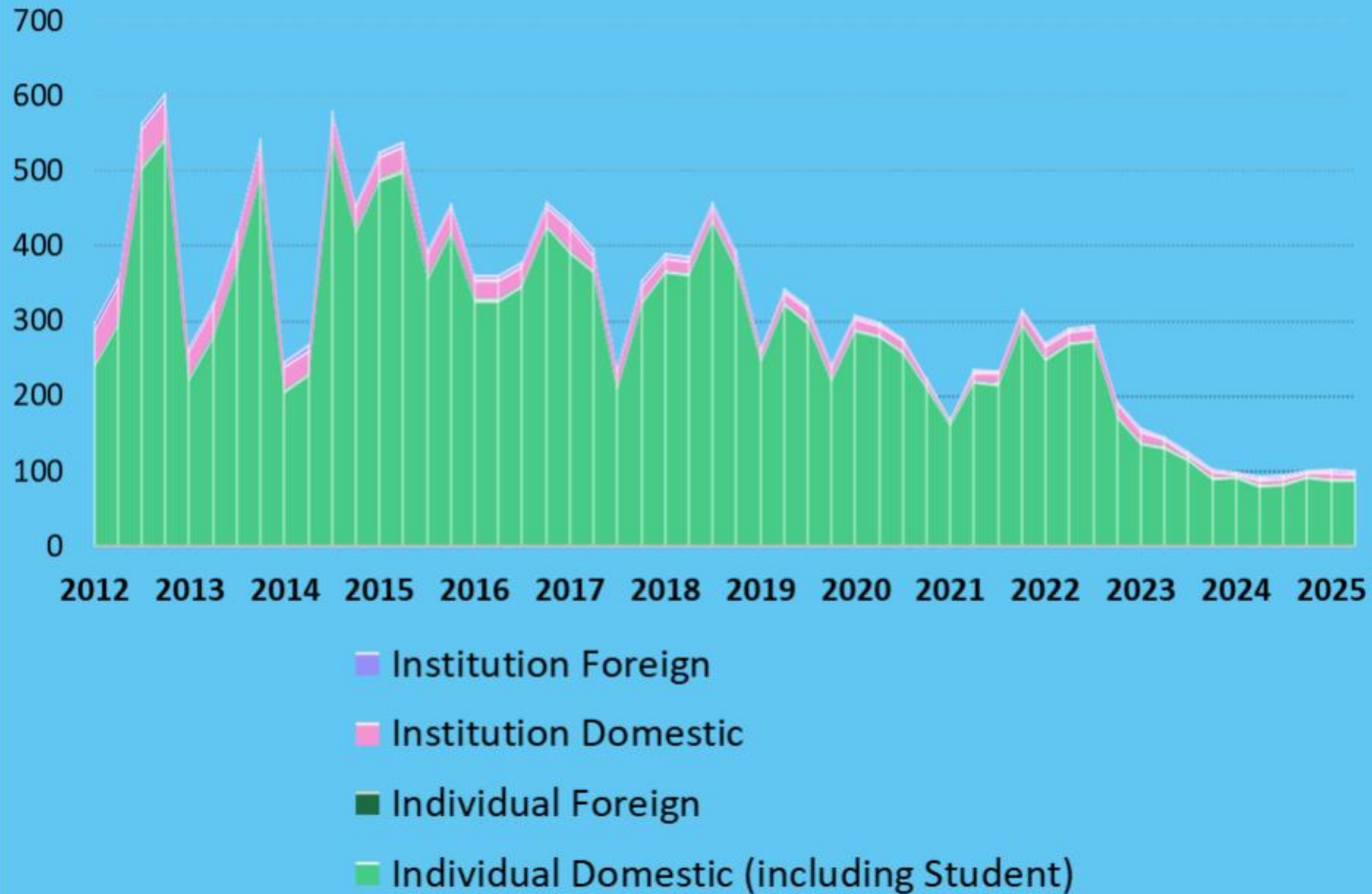

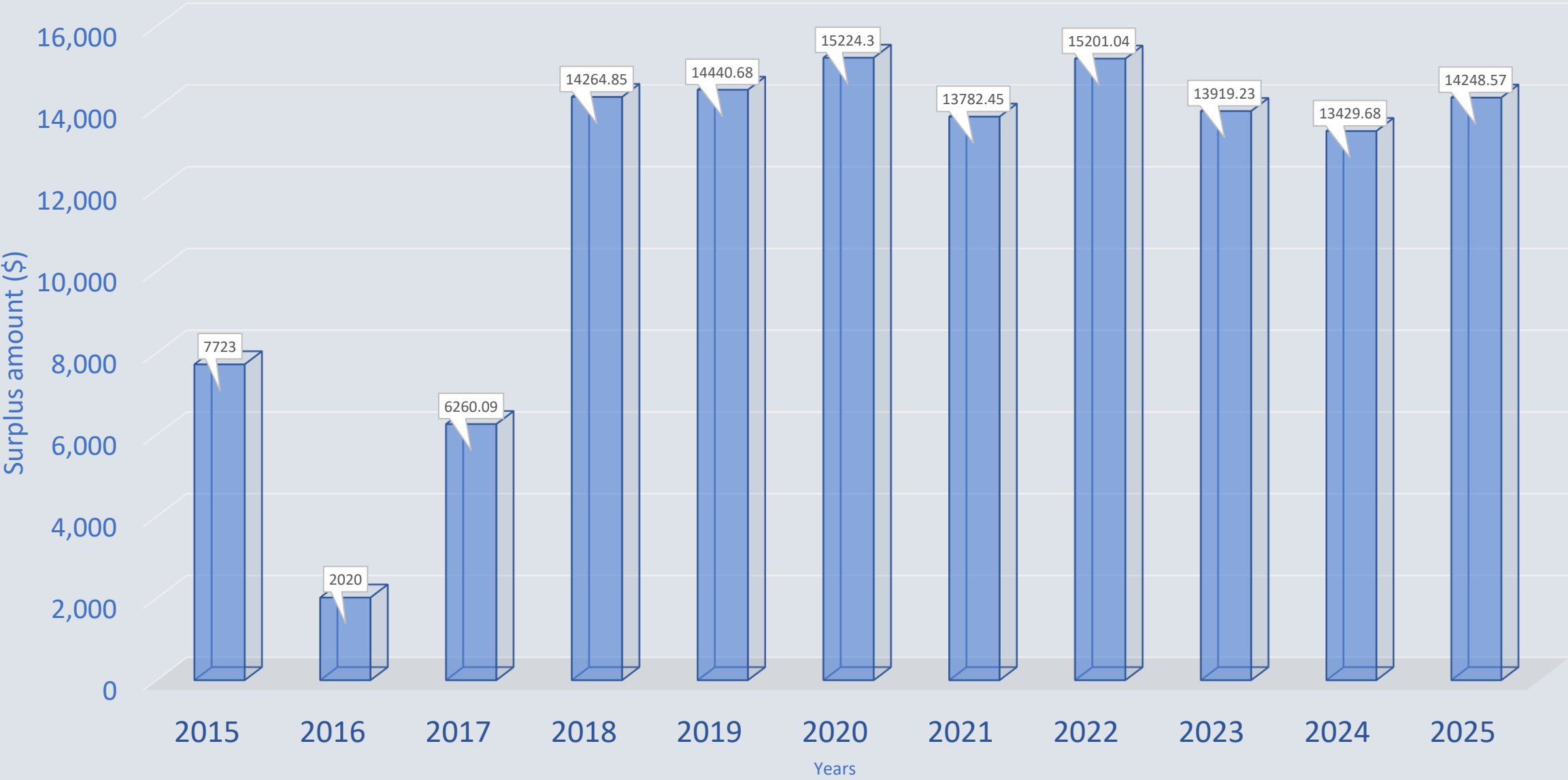
